STAFF ACTION IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS

A first aid kit will be available. School will be notified and in the event of a serious incident, parents and emergency services will be notified.

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED

Students need to wear a good pair of **running shoes**. Students should also bring a **labeled water bottle, morning tea (recess) and a sun smart hat**. Students will be given an Interschool shirt to wear.

Please note that: Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents/guardians should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent.

In the case of excursions not involving an overnight stay, costs incurred as a result of accident or illness, are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

The school camp/excursions insurance policy applies for approved camps/excursions involving an overnight stay. The policy covers students to a maximum of \$50,000 for medical and ancillary expenses where Medicare or private health insurance does not cover these costs.

Parents are required to inform the organisers well before the scheduled excursion departure of any change to their child's health and fitness so that appropriate supervision may be arranged.

Where it is considered necessary, school staff will arrange medical assessment and treatment for students.
