Dear Parents/Caregivers

The Coral Bay Camp is next week and you can no doubt see how excited all the students are as they begin their packing preparations! Please read and keep this information handy leading up to and during the camp.

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

<u>Medication</u>	If your child takes regular medication please drop it to the office in a clearly marked zip lock bag.
<u>Departure</u>	Please have your child in the Undercover Area on MONDAY 11 SEPTEMBER at 8am where they will have their name marked off the roll by their classroom teacher. The bus will leave promptly at 8:30am.
<u>Bus Trip</u>	Students can wear comfortable clothing on the bus and must bring a packed lunch in a LABELLED plastic or zip lock bag. They will be stopping over at Nanutarra Roadhouse to stretch their legs and eat lunch but will be unable to access the shop.
<u>Spending money</u>	All spending money must be given to Jack Powers on Monday morning in a sealed envelope that is clearly marked with your child's name. A maximum of \$100 please in small notes if possible.
<u>Arrival</u>	We return to Karratha on FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 15 and updates will be given on their arrival time through the school app.

REMEMBER: NO MOBILE PHONES OR ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT ARE ALLOWED ON CAMP, you can keep up to date with our exciting adventure via our school's Facebook page.

Students are invited to bring their own snorkel set if they have their own however they will be provided with one if you do not.
