On **Thursday 7 June**, Class 26 students will be undertaking an excursion to Ngurin (Harding River) Bush Tucker Trail, to enhance their knowledge of local history. With assistance from Amanda Mowarin, Ngarluma Elder, the students will experience a tour of the trail. The Ngurin (Harding River) and its surrounding vegetation holds great significance to the Ngarluma people, the traditional owners of this land. Students will have the opportunity to learn about sustainability, bush tucker, bush medicine and other artefacts used by Aboriginal people in their traditional way of life, with some still being used today.

Students will need to be at school by **8:45am**. We will be picked up by the Karratha Senior High School bus and will be joined by Mrs Nickie Ralph and some Karratha Senior High School students. The bus will depart Roebourne by **12.00pm** and will be returning to school by lunch. Supervision will be provided by Mrs Bishopp, Mrs Giddens, Mrs Ralph and Mr Parks. Students will need:

- Full school uniform with plain black shorts or school shorts/skorts, sun smart hat, water bottle, enclosed shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses (optional)
- Recess

The excursion is free and students will need to return the permission note and medical form by **Tuesday 5 June**.
