



Dear Parents/Caregivers

This term there have been schedule changes to this term, please see changes below. Please note that due to Years 3-5 swimming lessons in week 4 and 5 and other school programmes such as NAPLAN in week 3 the timetable will be modified during this time.

Morning Routine

Classroom doors will open at 8:05am every morning. Children are expected to remain seated outside their classroom if they arrive prior to doors opening. On Monday mornings children will change their readers and engage in morning writing. On Wednesday mornings children are to change their home reader and read at their desks. On Friday mornings children can read their library books at their desks. On Tuesday and Thursday, children will participate in Mathematics activities that will be arranged by the teacher.

Homework

Home reading

Children are expected to engage in reading Monday through to Thursday for at least 10 minutes each night. We are now only changing books twice to a week to ensure children become fluent and are able to comprehend what they are reading. We will be sending a list of questions which you will need to ask your child each day.

Mathletics

Each child has been provided with a Mathletics log-in which is stuck into their home reading folder. Each fortnight students will be assigned a number of tasks which reflect the learning in the classroom. It is expected that all children will at least complete the assigned tasks. We encourage children to engage with the online challenge to develop their mathematical fluency. If you do not have access to the internet, please let us know as soon as possible and your child will be provided with a fortnightly mathematic sheet. Children's homework will be regularly checked and they will be rewarded using our classroom management system.

Our class assembly is going to be held in Term 3. More information will become available closer to the time.

Crunch and Sip

At Baynton West Primary School we participate in the Crunch and Sip program. Students are given time every day to snack on healthy fruit and vegetables and drink water.
