To continue and enhance our Term 3 theme of aliens and space, we are planning to take the Pre-primary children to a live performance of the play Yo Diddle Diddle at the Red Earth Arts Precinct.

This performance is based on the children's book The Cow Tripped Over the Moon, by Tony Wilson. We will be using this excursion as the Talk 4 Writing "hook", to gain and maintain enthusiasm and participation in our class work during the second half of the term. The above text and the play will be referred to in many Curriculum areas after our excursion. Viewing the play at Karratha's new REAP is also a great opportunity for the students to experience live theatre in a public setting.
