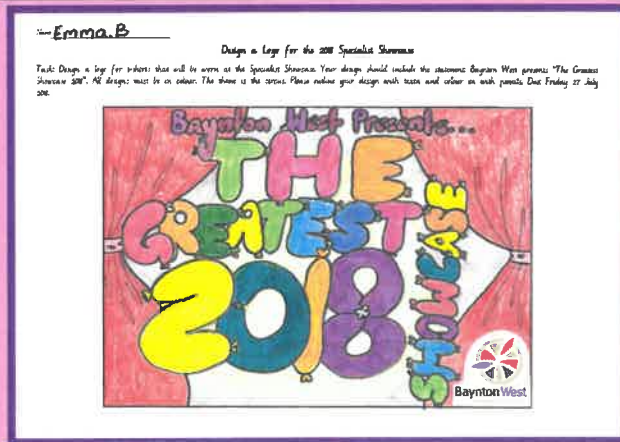

In July 2017 I travelled to Boston and participated in a seven day session of intensive world-class leadership development at Harvard University. On return all principals are to complete the three month online component delivered by Harvard University staff. The principals explore the concept of the importance of managing change. Simultaneously, we worked on an executive Mentor touring program around system level change.

My involvement in the program was finalised last Friday when I attended the graduation ceremony and received my certificate from the Hon. Sue Ellery MLC, Minister for Education and Training.

I look forward to using this knowledge to provide an even better education for the students of Baynton West Primary School.
